



To Do List

Creating an environment to stimulate play

1. Engage with children, staff, parents and carers regarding a wish list of what they would like to see in the outdoor playspace, noting what they would like to keep in the existing space (see Audit table)
2. Establish a landscape planning team
3. Audit what currently works and what does not including trees, vegetation, rooms or zones, sun angles
4. Identify the range of opportunities for play you want to create eg. Mud patch, calm spaces, drama play etc.
5. Create rooms that contain active, open and quiet spaces
6. Consult with an expert regarding soil testing and appropriate plants
7. Prepare a concept plan for staff and families and relevant governing bodies
8. Begin fundraising activities
9. Start slowly, working on one area or one activity at a time.
10. Gain support from staff and families regarding working bees
