## WHAT WE DO

Members can pick and choose how they want to be involved with Play Australia – for example:

- Participate in our national campaigns
- Attend our online learning series
- Access information and advice
- Promote their Play Australia
   Membership and value of play
- Obtain discounts on products and services
- Provide feedback to Play Australia via the annual member survey
- Vote at the AGM

Branches provide a key platform within states/territories to progress play.

Operations are self-determined – for example:

- Host local play network meetings
- Disseminate state-based information
- Represent Play AUS on state-based committees, based on interest.
- Support new member acquisition
- Support national campaign roll-out (i.e. resource sharing)
- Provide feedback to National Office on Member/Branch needs to inform national strategy

The National Board is responsible for the governance of the organisation in overseeing all legal and financial responsibilities of Play AUS, as well as determining organisational strategy.

The Board provides key strategic inputs through its Resources & Governance Committee and Executive, and further sub-groups as required.

The Board and staff work closely together to ensure effective outcomes and accountabilities.

The National Office is responsible for the daily operations that deliver on our organisational strategy – for example:

- Deliver national campaigns and resources
- Deliver PD and training including disseminating latest Australian Standards advice
- Build partnership models to support play at a local level.
- Coordinate regular advocacy (e-News, social media) and supply corporate branding
- Provide value to members,
   Members News, and run annual member survey
- Deliver a viable business model with strong revenue
